

A1123 will Increase Child Support Compliance

Fathers and Mothers both reported **the highest voluntary compliance with child support payments** in cases where joint custody was ordered over the objection of the Mother.¹

*Involved parents support their children!
Respected parents support their children!*

*Current NY Policy virtually **insures sole custody** if either parent objects to joint custody.*

A-1123 will, increase child support paid and reduce state enforcement costs.
